



2022 Woodlawn Croquet Mini Lobster Tournament

Croquet in early September on the coast of Maine, "The Way Life Should Be." Come to Maine and enjoy our beautiful rock bound coast, our scenic beauty, and Maine Lobsters. The Woodlawn Croquet Mini Lobster tournament is open to all USCA members and is a six wicket singles USCA sanctioned tournament. Tournament play will center on the championship sized court next to the Historic black House on the grounds of the 180 acre Woodlawn Museum in Ellsworth, Maine. The other courts being used will be the Hinckley Court in Southwest Harbor and the Sorrento VIA Court in Sorrento. Courts will be open for practice on Wednesday afternoon, September 7, 2022.

Our opening reception will be held Wednesday evening, September 7 at the Woodlawn croquet Facility in Ellsworth at 6PM. Tournament packets will be handed out and beer, wine, and appetizers will be available.

We can accommodate 30 players in 4 flights with spirited play commencing on Thursday morning, September 8 and end with the finals matches on Sunday, September 11. Trophies will be awarded to the first and second place winners in each flight. Tournament fees includes: white hooded sweatshirt, opening reception, daily courtside continental breakfast and lunches, Friday night dinner at the Ironbound restaurant in Hancock, Maine, awards, and Sunday Lunch. Entry Deadline is Friday, August 27, 2022. Tournament info and entry form will also be available on the Museum website, www.woodlawnmuseum.org, click on events.

We will provide more detailed info to all players approximately a week or so prior to the tournament such as GPS directions to each court, flight assignments, and all pertinent information. Tentative Tournament schedule:

Wednesday, September 7: Courts open for practice and opening reception at 6 PM at Woodlawn

Thursday and Friday, September 8 and 9: Block Play each day. Tournament dinner at Ironbound Restaurant in Hancock with cash bar at 6 PM and dinner served at 7PM.

Saturday, September 10: Elimination format to determine the top 2 players.

Sunday, September 11: Championship games at Woodlawn in each flight.
